Wellness Devices

Wellness Devices, such as a weight scale, pulse oximeter, glucometer, and/or blood pressure monitor, can be added to the GrandCare System to record health information. These Wellness Devices are battery-operated and Bluetooth-enabled to communicate wirelessly with the system.

Caregivers can log onto the <u>Online Care Portal</u> to view health readings and to setup custom <u>Wellness Notifications and Acknowledgements</u>.

Wireless Bluetooth

All wellness devices communicate with the system via Bluetooth. Systems that include health devices must have a Bluetooth Antenna.



Taking Wellness Readings

Follow all manufacturer-provided directions for setting up and using wellness devices, including battery installation, taking accurate readings, and device care.

All wellness devices within range of the system, **except for the glucometer**, will automatically upload readings to the GrandCare System.

Glucometer

The glucometer comes with manufacturer-provided directions for taking a safe and accurate reading.

When the blood glucose reading appears on the meter's display screen, press the Down Arrow button once to send the reading to the system.

Uploading Multiple Readings

If the resident has been away from home - on vacation, for example - and has taken numerous glucometer readings while away, you can upload all the readings at once by following these steps:

- 1. Make sure the glucometer is off (in a powered-down state).
- 2. While the glucometer is off, press the Down Arrow button once. This will upload all the readings currently stored on the glucometer.
